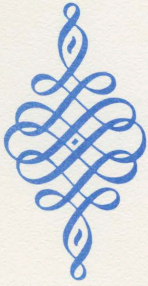

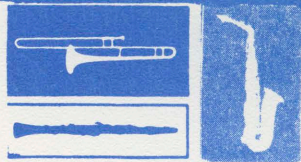

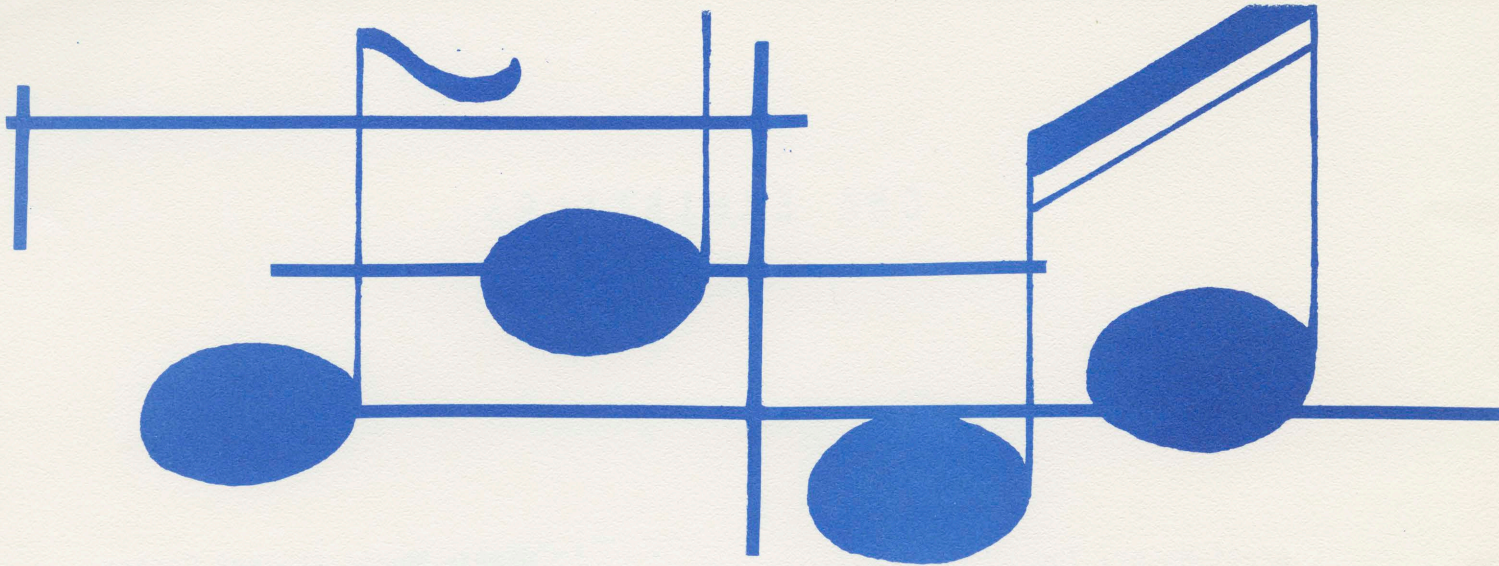
Dr. James Froseth is a distinguished authority on testing, recruitment and teaching of Band Beginners. This is a unique program for maintaining the beginner. Dr. Froseth's teaching experience includes High School Band, Kenosha, Wisconsin; Director of Bands, Wisconsin State; Faculty, University of Wisconsin; and he has been Music Researchist and Consultant at University of Michigan since 1971.

Lt. Col. Richard E. Thurston, the Commander and Conductor of the 120 piece United States Air Force Academy Band, was selected for this position because of his outstanding musical background and ability. He entered the USAF music program in 1961. Prior to his Academy assignment, he served as Training Officer of the USAF Bandsman School at Bolling Air Force Base in Washington, D.C.; Associate Conductor of the Air Force Band of the West at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas; Commander of the Pacific Air Forces Band, Hickam Air Force Base, Hawaii and Supervisor of all Air Force Bands in the Pacific; and Commander of the Tactical Air Command Band, Langley Air Force Base, Virginia.

Mr. Don Baird received his BS from Phillips University, Enid, Oklahoma, and his MED from the University of Illinois. He was the Euphonium Soloist with the US Army Band, Washington, D.C., taught in the Odessa, Texas Schools, was Director of Bands at Phillips University, and is at present Assistant Director of Bands at West Texas State University. He is a member of Phi Beta Mu, Phi Mu Alpha, Kappa Kappa Psi and CBDNA. It is with a great deal of pride that we welcome Don to CBA.

Mr. Bob Hurrell, the Director of the Arvada High School Summer Band, is a graduate of the University of Wyoming, with a BA and MA Degree. He taught at Golden 1 year prior to his military service, taught in the Elementary Schools of Jefferson County for 1 year, Brush Public Schools for 4 years, and has been Director of Bands at Arvada High School for the past 15 years.
