Our Marching Clinician this year is Dr. James Jurrens, Director of Bands and Chairman of the Music Department at Southwestern Oklahoma State College, Weatherford, Oklahoma. Jim received his Bachelors from Dakota Wesleyan U., Masters from the University of South Dakota, and his Doctorate from UNC, Greeley. His teaching experience includes three years in rural schools, nine years in secondary, and eighteen years as a college instructor. His Southwestern State College Bands have performed for such NFL teams as THE DENVER BRONCOS, Detroit Lions, St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Cheifs, and this fall will perform at the Dallas Cowboy-New York Giant game.

Dr. Jurrens is a member of Kappa Kappa Psi, Phi Mu Alpha, CBDA, MENC and OBA. He is the Oklahoma chairman for NBA, and also serves as Southwest District Chairman for that organization.

A native of Indiana, Mr. Metz received his B.S. and M.S. degrees in music education at Indiana State U. His considerable academic credits include graduate work at Wayne State U. in Detroit and Niagara U., Lewiston, New York. His varied career in education spans eighteen years in all music areas in Michigan, New York and Wisconsin. He conducted the Michigan All-State Band and Orchestra at Interlochen for three successive years and has held district and state chairmanships for band, orchestra, solo and ensemble festivals. Metz is a member of A.S.B.D.A., Phi Mu Alpha, Theta Chi, Blue Key and Phi Delta Kappa.

Two innovative programs that are sparking unusual educator response are the newly released Learning Unlimited Class Series (LUCS) and individualized cassette/book Learning Unlimited Band Series (LUBS). We're fortunate to have a guest speaker who is thoroughly familiar with the programs and has directly contributed his educator expertise to their creation and production.

The beginning Guitar Method, courtesy of Selmer Co., will be taught by Mr. Frank Gibson. Mr. Gibson, a native of Arkansas, has taught in the schools of Louisiana, played in an Army band during his service hitch, has been in retail sales for sixteen years, the last six with Selmer. 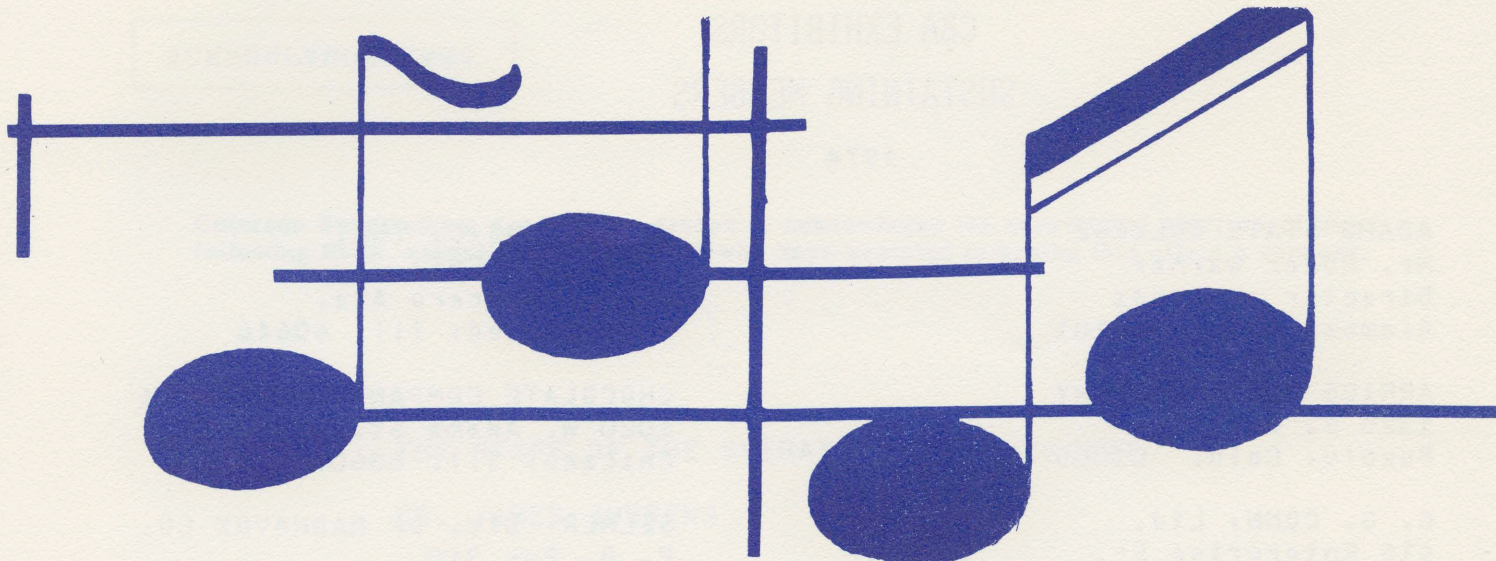
