
Our Marching Clinician this year is Mr. Dan Gibbs. Mr. Gibbs has been the Director of the Monahans, Texas High School Band for the past 17 years. During that time, his band has won the Outstanding Band Award at Buccaneer Festival, Corpus Christi, Texas; performed many times on national television for the Dallas Cowboys; performed in concert at MENC in Albuquerque, New Mexico; 2nd place winner in Disneyland National Marching Contest; named Outstanding Class AAA band in Texas by TBA; won the Sweepstakes Trophy at Canon City, and has been a consistent winner of the Texas University Interscholastic league Sweepstakes award for many years. We welcome Dan to our 1975 Convention.

The NORAD Band is the only one of its kind anywhere. The Band is made up of members representing the Army, Navy, Air Force and the Canadian Armed Forces. The Band was organized at Peterson Field, Colorado Springs, in 1959. Director of the NORAD Band is USAF Maj. Melvin Hewitt, a native of Reading, PA. Assistant Director is Capt. Keith Swanwick, a native of Manchester, England and a graduate of Neller Hall. CBA welcomes the NORAD Band.

Bill Hill is currently Director of Bands at California State University. His wife, Janet teaches elementary music for the Pasadena Unified School District. Bill has many friends in Colorado, having received BM and MA Degrees from University of Northern Colorado, Greeley. This is the Hill's newest publication in the field, and we in CBA look forward to it.

Considered to be one of the top specialists in flag technique, color guard, and the use of flags in the marching band, Ms. Marie Kas has a long history of thaching and desingning shows for nationally recognized bands and drum and bugle corps. Ms. Kas serves as staff clinician, and also as technical advisor for the nation's leading marching band specialists and supplier, McCormick's Enterprises, Inc. of Elk Grove Village, Illinois. We welcome Ms. Kas to CBA.

The Denver Kicks Band is a nineteen piece group of teachers, professional people who, as the name implies, get together each Wednesday evening to play the newest stage band music, as well as the old standards. The band plays numerous concerts at schools in the Metro area, and includes some of the area's top musicians. The leader of the Kicks Band is Mr. Lynn Zorric.
